The purpose of the scholarship is to provide members and new carvers with assistance when they may not be able to otherwise attend without support. Scholarships amounts vary depending on need and are made possible by the generous contributions of members either directly or through our annual fundraising auction. If applying for work-study also (highly recommended), please submit that form first. It should be noted that full scholarships are rarely awarded. Recipients will be expected to make the most of their award by utilizing their carving time to the utmost and contributing a great attitude!

- DEADLINE for scholarship applications is **Wednesday, June 1st 2016, 5:00 p.m.** You will be notified no later than June 15th regarding the status of your application.
- Fill out this application form, either on paper (if handwritten, please print legibly) or electronically and attach required images. Incomplete forms will not be considered. If any question does not apply to you in this application please put N/A in the space.

Application Process:

- Complete the application form.
- Include up to two (2) letters of recommendation (or email) from individuals with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement, and if needed permission to contact reference.
- Attach up to five (5) images of work.
- Complete package received by Symposium Director by above published due date: **Wednesday, June 1st 2016, 5pm.** Applications postmarked, or received electronically, after this date will not be considered.

Scholarships to the symposium will be awarded based on evidence of an interest and history of carving stone and financial need.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must explain their interest in stone carving and provide up to five images of their work.
2. Applicant must explain their financial need (see question below).
3. Applicant must have letters of recommendation from individuals with knowledge of applicant's work.
